

### Eagle Scout Improves Clinton Nature Trail Report

On June 4, David Foote of Troop 37 of Hyde Park was recognized by the Town of Clinton Supervisor Jeff Burns for his work done on the Clinton Nature Trail for his Eagle Project. The project was completed in August 2010. It is located on the north side of the Town Hall at 1215 Centre Road (County Route 18, north of Schultzville). David enlisted the help of volunteers from his Troop, as well as from his father, and adult advisors, Kurt and Barbara Schollmeyer, to complete his project. David organized the trail's cleanup and performed maintenance. He also created a new entrance sign and numbered trail signs marking features of the trail. These features, of which there are twelve in total, include stream, wetlands, and tree species. He also created a brochure describing these features. David and his father conducted months of research and work in order to complete the project. Both the Town Board and the CAC also thank David for his excellent work which will enable many people to enjoy the Clinton Nature Trail.
