



Instructions For On Line Legislation

Words in quotes are for clarification of content. The quotes are not used when searching. Please note that the numbering system has been revised in and, for example, the zoning law sections are different from earlier publications.

Once you have arrived at the website, you will be able to search on key words, a specific section or select a chapter.

To Search by Key Word: Please refer to the upper left corner of the example screen. If using key words, try to use as unique a word or words as possible. For instance, "ATV" (no quotes) will not produce any results. If you're looking for the regulations on the use of ATVs, use "all terrain" because that is the way it is worded in town regulations. However, "motor vehicle" can be used as a less restrictive search. Try different word(s) you think the regulations may have in them.

To Search by Section or Chapter: Please refer to the upper left corner of the example screen. Using the Motor Vehicle/ATV/All Terrain example, you could go directly to that regulation by searching on "229-3" in the "specific section number" box. To select a Chapter, go to the Chapter Box to the right of the search area and click the down arrow to the right of the Chapter as illustrated above.

In the example, the down arrow has already been clicked on to show you the options it provides. If you select "Print", the content prints as viewed. If sections are opened, they may be more than your computer screen can show you and their content is printed - (this could mean you have asked to print many pages). If sections are closed, only the section number and title print.
