PUBLIC HEARING

Supervisor Oberly opened the floor to comments. There were no audience members. Councilman Werner explained that we are updating the 1971 law regulating large gatherings. The law will regulate gatherings with 500 or more people rather than the previous number of more than 5000 people in attendance.

Dean comment. Page 4 of law: 159-6 wants the insurance language spelled out. The Board agrees. Dean will provide the updated wording.

Sect 159 – 3 : suggested to change the language to read within a 24 hour period.

The Town Board will send the changes to the attorney for review
