A public hearing on proposed LL XX of 2018, **Increasing the Alternate Veterans Exemption**, was held on this day in the Town Hall. Present were Supervisor Oberly, Councilmen Dean Michael, Eliot Werner, Michael Whitton and Nancy Cunningham, and Town Clerk Carol-Jean Mackin. There were 6 people in the audience.

### **PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

At 6:25 PM, Supervisor Oberly called the public hearing to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Town clerk read the public hearing notice aloud.

### **BUSINESS:**

The Supervisor opened the floor for comments:

Dean Michael said the assessor did the research on 2500 parcels, 184 are affected, a value of less than half of one percent of total Town value. Dean listed the new exemption values that will go into effect January of 2019.

The impact to the Town is an \$11 increase to taxes on an assessed value of \$350,000 home; the exemption offers a \$53 dollar savings to the vets that qualify.

There being no further comments, the Supervisor called the public hearing to a close.
