

July 24, 2018 Town Board Workshop

The Clinton Town Board held a Special Town Board Workshop on this day in the Town Hall. Present were Supervisor Ray Oberly and Council people Michael Whitton and Eliot Werner. These people were not present Council people Nancy Cunningham and Dean Michael and Town Clerk Carol-Jean Mackin. There were seventeen people in the audience.

Supervisor Oberly called the meeting to order at 7:05 PM and introduced the speaker Javier Barrios, Managing Partner for Good Energy (866-955-2677). Their company was selected by both the New York Association of Towns and the New York Conference of Mayors to form a program called New York Municipal Energy Program (NYMEP) to be a shared services initiative to purchase electricity through a cost-effective energy cooperative. His PowerPoint presentation is attached and provides the initiative details. There are two parts to the shared services, one for Town government use and the other for the Town's residents, farmers, and businesses. A local law and some resolutions need to be passed and quotes obtained from various electricity suppliers. Then the Town approves the fixed price for electricity for a fixed number of years. This commitment would be made in the spring of 2019. A question was asked if green energy could be supplied. Yes it can be supplied from a green source but at an additional cost.

Supervisor Oberly adjourned the workshop at 8:15 PM.
