PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

At 6:30 PM, Supervisor Oberly called the continued public hearing to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Town Clerk read the public hearing notice aloud.

Supervisor Oberly opened the floor for comments and turned the meeting over to Councilman Whitton.

Kevin Magus – feels the permitting process would encourage commercial rentals. Concerned hosted vs non hosted are ambiguous. Concerned about the fact that certificates of occupancy and GFI permits in older homes are nonexistent, so the permitting process must take this into account. Annual renewal process is onerous and favors commercial interests who have the resources and time to dedicate vs residents who rent their home several times a year to offset annual costs of home ownership.

Councilman Whitton read emails he received from Kim Punchar and Joanne Schmidt; attached.

Councilman Whitton said DC Planning sent many comments on the law mostly to make wording more concise. It is attached. The Town Attorney is updating the law to incorporate these suggestions.
