This assistance is only for those who may not have other means of ascertaining needed provisions, such as non-quarantined family members or neighbors. However, when no option is available, we are here to help. Additionally, if you know any qualifying individuals, please contact us.

To request a delivery of the aforementioned items, help is only a phone call away. A member of the fire company will call and let you know when your package will be delivered and leave it outside your door.
