**RESOLUTION OF INTRODUCTION**

**Local Law No. XX of 2018**

The following proposed local law, to be known as Local Law No. XX of 2018 of the Town of Clinton, entitled “Amendments to Article II of Chapter 214 of the Town Code Extending Certain Prohibited Activities to All Town Owned Properties”, a copy of which is attached hereto and made part hereof, is hereby introduced.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Clinton (the “Town Board”) has determined that a local law amending Article II of Chapter 214 of the Town Code in order to extend the applicability of the prohibited activities contain in Section 214-4 of the Town Code to all Town owned property is necessary and in the best interest of the Town in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of its’ citizens; and

WHEREAS, this action is permitted by Section 268 of the New York Town Law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that a public hearing be held in relation to the proposed Local Law as set forth in the form of notice, hereinafter provided, at which hearing parties in interest and citizens shall have an opportunity to be heard, to be held at the Town Hall on May 8, 2018, at 6:25 o’clock p.m., Prevailing Time, and that notice of said meeting shall be published in the official newspaper of general circulation in the Town of Clinton by the Town Clerk, at least five (5) days before such hearing and that such notice shall be in the following form:

Y. Town Law.

This Local Law will take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State. Complete copies of the proposed Local Law are available at the Town of Clinton Clerk's Office for inspection during regular business hours.

All interested persons and citizens shall have an opportunity to be heard on said proposals at the date, time and place aforesaid.
