**RESOLUTION APPROVING DOG CONTROL HOUSING AGREEMENT WITH DUTCHESS COUNTY SPCA**

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board desires to enter into an agreement with the Dutchess County SPCA to perform certain functions related to the housing of dogs seized pursuant to Article 7 § 117 of the New York State Agriculture & Markets Law and Chapter 98 § 9 of the Town Code;

**WHEREAS**, by separate Resolution the Town Board approved a Dog Control Services Agreement with the Dutchess County SPCA wherein the Dutchess County SPCA agreed to perform certain functions related to the control of dogs, including acting as the Town’s Dog Control Officer and enforcing Chapter 98 of the Town Code and Article 7 of the New York State Agriculture & Markets Law; and

**WHEREAS**, a copy of the Dog Control Housing Agreement is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit “A”; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board has determined that entering into said Dog Control Housing Agreement is necessary and in the best interest of the people of the Town.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Town Board of the Town of Clinton approves the attached Dog Control Housing Agreement with the Dutchess County SPCA; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the Town Supervisor of the Town of Clinton be and he hereby is authorized, empowered, and directed to execute the attached Dog Control Housing Agreement and to take any and all actions necessary to implement the provisions of said Dog Control Housing Agreement.
