

**TOWN OF CLINTON
RESOLUTION NO. 43 OF 2018**

TITLE: Hollow Road Curves Safety

WHEREAS, as part of the safety concern for driving and bicycling in the Town of Clinton, the Town requests that Dutchess County Transportation Committee undertake a study as part of their Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP), and

WHEREAS, the section of Hollow Road (CR 14) between West Cookingham Drive and North Creek Road in the Frost Mills Hamlet has had many accidents involving cars, trucks, motorcycles, and occasionally pedestrians due to sliding on wet, ice, and snow road surfaces and by going too fast, and

WHEREAS, additionally there are no shoulders to allow for the safety of the pedestrians, and

WHEREAS, the study should look at improvements in the cited curves section of road or evaluate the construction of a by-pass route, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board approves requesting the study to improve the traffic safety of the curves on the defined section of Hollow Road.
