

**TOWN OF CLINTON  
RESOLUTION NO. 44 OF 2018**

**TITLE: Salt Point Turnpike Path**

**WHEREAS**, as part of the safety concern for pedestrians and bicyclists in the Town of Clinton, the Town requests that Dutchess County Transportation Committee undertake a study as part of their Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP), and

**WHEREAS**, the section of Salt Point Turnpike (CR 17) from Friends Park west to Stewarts by the Taconic Parkway in the Hamlet of Clinton Corners where the Town has received many complaints about the traffic speed while the children walk and/or bicycle on the roadway when going from the Park to Stewarts, and

**WHEREAS**, many of the children come from the Boys Little League playing in the Park and children and families live in the Heritage Road subdivision going to and from home to the Park to play and to Stewarts for treats, and

**WHEREAS**, additionally there are no shoulders to allow for the safety of the pedestrians and bicyclists, and

**WHEREAS**, the study should look at improvements along the cited road to reduce traffic speed and better protect the pedestrians and bicyclists.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town Board approves requesting the study to improve the safety of the pedestrians and bicyclists on the defined section of Salt Point Turnpike.
