

RESOLUTION 49 of 2019

At a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Clinton, held at Town of Clinton Town Hall, 1215 Center Road, Rhinebeck, New York, on the 10th day of December, 2019, at 6:30 p.m.,

Town Supervisor, Raymon Oberly called the meeting to order, and upon roll call, the following were present:

Supervisor Oberly moved the following resolution, seconded by Councilman Michael, to wit:

WHEREAS, David Travis and Brittany Travis, petitioner in a Tax Certiorari proceeding brought pursuant to Article 7 of the New York Real Property Tax Law, against the Town of Clinton, the Assessor for the Town of Clinton and the Town of Clinton Board of Assessment Review seeking reduction of the assessment of the following property located in the Town of Clinton designated by tax identification number 6466-00-233376-0000 (278 Clinton Hollow Road).

WHEREAS, the attorney for petitioner, Griffin, Coogan, Sulzer & Horgan, P.C., Matthew S. Clifford, Esq., and the attorneys for the Town of Clinton, Cappillino, Rothschild & Egan LLP have entered into a tentative settlement agreement of the Tax Certiorari Proceeding, subject to approval by the Clinton Town Board, whereby the assessed value of the properties would be reduced as indicated;

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Clinton must approve said settlement by resolution, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Clinton now wishes to approve said settlement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Clinton hereby authorizes the attorneys for the Town of Clinton, Cappillino, Rothschild & Egan LLP, to enter into a Stipulation with the attorney for petitioner, Griffin, Coogan, Sulzer & Horgan, P.C., Matthew S. Clifford, Esq., the terms of which are set forth in the attached Stipulation and hereby authorizes the attorneys for the Town of Clinton, Cappillino, Rothschild & Egan LLP to sign said Stipulation on behalf of the Town of Clinton.
