### **OLD BUSINESS**

#### **1. Adopt 2021 Budget- Oberly**

The purpose of this Special Meeting is to approve the proposed 2021 Town Budget. The NYS Budget adoption must be done by November 20, 2020. These comments highlight and summarize the proposed Adopted Budget. The 2% (actual 1.56% for Clinton) Tax Cap for 2021 allowed for tax collection of \$1,646,716. The proposed Budget taxes are \$1,646,535 thus we are \$181 under the Tax Cap. The proposed 2021 Adopted Budget shows a \$0.03 increase (\$2.18 to \$2.21) in the tax rate per \$1,000 of assessment giving a 1.4% increase in the tax rate. Considering the uncertainty of 2021 revenues and the \$93,706 increase for the 2 snow plow trucks bond, these are significant new changes to the Budget. The rest of the details are shown in the 2021 Budget which will be available on the Town web page [www.TownofClinton.com](http://www.TownofClinton.com) after adoption.

MM Supervisor Oberly, 2nd Councilman Michael to approve the following resolution: BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board approves **Resolution No. 51 of 2020** adopting a budget for the Fiscal Year commencing January 1, 2021 and ending December 31, 2021 making

appropriations for the Conduct of the Town of Clinton Government and Establishing the Rates of Compensation for Officers and Employees for such period.
