### **PUBLIC HEARING**

Supervisor Oberly said this is a public hearing concerning the adoption of the 2022 budget. He opened the floor for comments:

Katherine Mustello- asked about the difference in tonight's budget vs. the one from the Tuesday night. Ray Oberly said the Board made some changes at the last meeting so the numbers are slightly different. Councilman Juliano explained the process the Board followed last meeting.

Supervisor Oberly explained the PERMA savings for a two-year contract and to approve by next week we will save over \$8000 on next year's bill. Also, the highway crew will choose their medical plan next Wednesday so that may change the budget also by about \$2000.

Arlene Campbell - are you including longevity? Ray said yes.

At 6:42 PM, there being no further comments, MM Supervisor Oberly, 2nd Councilman Michael to close the public hearing. All aye. Motion carried.

MM Supervisor Oberly, 2<sup>nd</sup> Councilman Michael that the Town Board approves the following resolution: BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board approves doing a two-year contract with PERMA for 2022 and 2023 and pay the 2022 Premium of \$41,158.00. All aye. Motion carried.

MM Councilman Whitton, 2nd Councilman Juliano to appoint Michael Galantich to the Planning Board, filling the unexpired term of Sara Love who resigned, for a term of office of November 12, 2021 to December 31, 2024. All aye. Motion carried.
