2. Approve Historical Society's CDBG Application - Oberly

MM Supervisor Oberly, 2nd Councilman Michael to approve the following resolution: BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board **approves Resolution No. 53 of 2021**, approving the Dutchess County Community Development Consortium Fiscal Year 2022-2023 application, and that the submission of said application to the Dutchess County Department of Planning and Development be and hereby is authorized by the Town Board.
