

Grand Marshal Bill Dickett:

A Life Well-Lived and A Town Well-Served

Grand Marshal Bill Dickett has been instrumental in shaping the growth of the Town of Clinton since buying his Schoolhouse Road home in 1973. The Dickett's were first introduced to the Town of Clinton when Bill helped a friend move here. Living in Fishkill at the time, Bill, an avid outdoorsman, loved the area and thought this would be a great place to raise his family. So he and his wife Barbara, who passed away on September 20, 2018, purchased property nearby where Bill continues to reside.

After their Schoolhouse Road home was finally complete, Bill was eager to get involved in the Town as public service is something he finds rewarding. Before moving to Clinton he and an IBM colleague saw the need for a police presence in Fishkill where they lived at the time. Together they started the Fishkill Police Department and Bill created the Police Explorer Post, a youth policing program. He was its first advisor responsible for supporting and mentoring future police officers.


With his roots firmly planted in Clinton and four children now at home, Bill became a member of the Recreation Committee where his steadfast commitment and guidance resulted in many of the recreational activities we enjoy today. Together with Recreation Director Dan Harkenrider, Bill started the swimming program at the Fran Mark Rec Park pond. He was also instrumental in persuading the Town Board to make improvements to Friends Park, including putting fencing around the ballfield, constructing permanent bathrooms and adding picnic tables. Working with the Rec Committee members, Bill laid the foundation of activities offered at both Rec Parks, which we all continue to use and enjoy today.

Bill was soon recruited and elected to the position of Town Councilman. As a Town Board member his philosophy of "never accomplishing anything alone" was on full display as his colleagues were tasked with writing the 1991 Zoning Law. To allow them the time to work on the Law, Bill took on the liaison duties of two other Board members, resulting in a nightly Town meeting schedule. No complaints, as the entire Board took pride in the passing of the Law, a testament to being a true team player.

Notable achievements while a Town Board member include working with CAC Chair Norene Coller to open the Transfer Station and encouraging recycling thirty years ago. In addition, Bill was Chairman of the Cable TV Committee where his guidance was instrumental in negotiating the first contract for Townwide cable installation and service. Other volunteer positions Bill has held in the years since have been as a member of the CAC, SSIP, Historical Society Trustee, Lions Club member, Cable TV Committee, Clinton Community Day Committee, Masonic Lodge Restoration Committee, a member of the Clinton Business Association, and the current Recreation Committee. Tom Myers, a longtime friend and former Town Board member who served with Bill, said "Bill knows everybody in Town. He has done more for this Town than anyone I've known in 50 years."

One of the most rewarding achievements to Bill is his work with the Lions Club and their vision screening program for children aged 6 months to 6 years old. Together with Don Bartles, he would travel across the County and screen up to 400 children per year.

For five decades, Bill has continued to bring his infectious enthusiasm and a team spirit to any position he holds. Leading quietly and by example, Bill continues to be a driving force behind many Town projects encouraging colleagues to work together to accomplish common goals.




