Storms – there was a total of (7) weather related work days this month

Cold Patch work took place on various roads this month. The freeze-thaw cycle of winter weather causes cracks and the plowing results in potholes, so it becomes necessary to repair with a cold patch material providing a temporary fix during colder temperatures.

Dirt roads received a layer of fresh gravel and stone. This helps to provide a stable, hard surface, prevent mud and also allow the road to withstand the weights of heavier vehicles during the Spring season.

Equipment Maintenance was performed by the crew on the Back-hoe and several sanders.

Drainage work was done in preparation of the Spring storms. Catch basins were cleaned to better collect and direct the stormwater

Interdepartmental Aid - Bucket truck was borrowed from Milan through the Shared Services agreement for a couple of days to take down the Christmas lights around the Town Hall complex
