Lindsey Brown Area Variance to change home occupation to an Accessory structure – property located at 99 Willow Lane, Tax Grid No. 6562-00-193832

The applicant wishes to do home occupation in an existing accessory structure when the regulation allows home occupation in the principal dwelling pursuant to Sec. 250-56.

Sec. 250.56 (Home Occupation) which states that "A home occupation shall be conducted entirely within the principal residential structure; use of an accessory structure for other than storage is not permitted. No outdoor storage or displays shall be permitted.

- Note that this application was before the board back in October of 2024.
- Applicant withdrew the application and did not get the variance from the Zoning Board of Appeals.
- No changes to the proposed application.

Received neutral recommendation to the Zoning Board of Appeals.

Popolow Area Variance – property located at 205 E. Fallkill Road, Tax Grid No. 6266-00-81967.

The applicant requests an area variance to Sec. 250-22 A-4 to increase the number of accessory structures from the allowed three structures to 6 in order to allow construction of 2,000 square feet barn to house goats. This property is not a farm. It is a 37.8-acre lot in the AR5 Zoning District.

- Applicant received a variance for the detached garage in 2024.
- Received positive recommendation to the ZBA.

## **Town of Clinton Highway Department Report**

**Storms** – The month of April had the Highway crew cleaning roads on (2) different occasions both for a late season snow event and then for tree damage due to a wind and rain storm.

Guide Rail installation was done on Jameson Hill Rd, Schoolhouse Rd and Shadblow Lane.

Culvert Pipe improvements were made on East Cookingham Drive, Ruskey Lane and Rhynders Rd using the excavator. Replacement delineators were also installed.

**Road Sweeping** has begun. The crew put the broom attachment onto the JCB and began the annual town wide road cleanup.

Interdepartmental Aid was given to the Cemetery Dept. The Highway crew constructed a road and a parking pad in the rear lot in addition to fixing the drainage problem in the lower lot.

**Equipment Maintenance** was done on the plows, wings and sanders as they were taken off and stored till next season.
