

## **Resolution No. 10 of 2021**

### **RESOLUTION OF INTRODUCTION**

**Local Law No. \_\_\_\_\_ of 2021**

The following proposed local law, to be known as Local Law No. \_\_\_\_\_ of 2021 of the Town of Clinton, entitled “Amendment to Town Code – Municipal Code Enforcement Inspector”, a copy of which is attached hereto and made part hereof, is hereby introduced.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Clinton (the “Town Board”) has determined that amending the Town Code to add a definition for the position of Municipal Code Enforcement Inspector is necessary and in the best interest of the Town in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of its’ citizens and to protect the aesthetic qualities of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the action to adopt this proposed Local Law is a Type II Action under the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act regulations for which no environmental review is required;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Board hereby refers the proposed Local Law to the Dutchess County Department of Planning and Development for review and recommendations pursuant to 239-m of the New York General Municipal Law;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a public hearing be held in relation to the proposed Local Law as set forth in the form of notice, hereinafter provided, at which hearing parties in interest and citizens shall have an opportunity to be heard, to be held at the Town Hall on February 9, 2021, at 6:25 o’clock p.m., Prevailing Time, and that notice of said meeting shall be published in the official newspaper of general circulation in the Town of Clinton by the Town Clerk, at least five (5) days before such hearing and that such notice shall be in the following form:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Town of Clinton will hold a Public Hearing on Tuesday, February 9, 2021 via Zoom videoconference consistent with Executive Orders 202.1 and 202.15, as extended, addressing the COVID-19 virus at 6:25 p.m. Prevailing Time, or as soon thereafter as the matter is reached on the agenda, concerning proposed Local Law No. \_\_ of 2021, entitled, “Amendment to Town Code – Municipal Code Enforcement Inspector” pursuant to Article 16 of the N. Y. Town Law.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, due to public health concerns, in-person attendance will not be permitted, however the public will be fully able to observe and participate in the public hearing via computer, smartphone, tablet or other electronic device.

The public is invited to attend the public hearing held via ZOOM videoconference and comment on the proposed local law. Members the public who wish to comment at the public hearing will be able to do so by joining the meeting via Zoom – electronically or by telephone. The passcodes will be published by noon on February 8, 2021 which will enable the public to participate in the meeting. Comments for the public hearing can be submitted in advance of the public hearing by sending an email to townclerk@townofclinton.com by 3:00 on February 9, 2021.

This Local Law will take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State. Complete copies of the proposed Local Law are available at the Town of Clinton Clerk’s Office for inspection during regular business hours.

All interested persons and citizens shall have an opportunity to be heard on said proposals at the date, time and place aforesaid.
