The residents of Oak Grove Road are submitting a petition to the Town of Clinton to request to pave Oak Grove Road. Our road has become very difficult to traverse and has caused damage to our vehicles. With every rain storm it washes out to form deep ruts making it very narrow and hard to navigate. Due to snow plowing it has been graded down to the shale base in several places and cannot be further graded. The Town Highway department has spent many hours trying to repair and remediate it but all of the material used in the past to level the road has either been plowed to the end of the road or graded off to the sides where it inhibits drainage.
