Resolution No. 24 of 2022

Agreement for the Expenditure of Highway Moneys

AGREEMENT between the Town Highway Superintendent of the Town of Clinton, Dutchess County, New York, and the undersigned members of the Town Board.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 284 of the Highway Law, we agree that moneys levied and collected in the Town for the repair and improvement of highways, and received from the State for State Aid for the repair and improvement of highways, shall be expended as follows:

1. GENERAL REPAIRS. The sum of \$179,725.00 shall be set aside to be expended for primary work and general repairs upon 70 miles of town highways, including sluices, culverts and bridges having a span of less than five feet and boardwalks or renewals thereof.

2. PERMANENT IMPROVEMENTS. The following sums shall be set aside to be expended for the permanent improvement of Town highways:

(a) On the road commencing at Allen Road and leading to Oak Grove Road, a distance of .33 miles, there shall be expended not over the sum of \$114,804.00.

(b) On the road commencing at Hollow Road and leading to Allen Road, a distance of 1.92 miles, there shall be expended not over the sum of \$199,120.00.

Dear Town of Clinton Board Members,

The residents of Oak Grove Road are submitting a petition to the Town of Clinton to request to pave Oak Grove Road. Our road has become very difficult to traverse and has caused damage to our vehicles. With every rain storm it washes out to form deep ruts making it very narrow and hard to navigate. Due to snow plowing it has been graded down to the shale base in several places and cannot be further graded. The Town Highway department has spent many hours trying to repair and remediate it but all of the material used in the past to level the road has either been plowed to the end of the road or graded off to the sides where it inhibits drainage. It has become substantially worse year over year despite the efforts of the Town to maintain it. Many of us have lived here 20 plus years and understand the expense involved, so even if there were a way to pave the hilly sections that are most damaged (just past #39) that would be appreciated.
