RESOLUTION APPROVING REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT WITH HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT TODD MARTIN

WHEREAS, Todd Martin is the duly elected Highway Superintendent of the Town of Clinton having assumed the office of Town of Clinton Highway Superintendent on or about January 1, 2020;

WHEREAS, the Highway Superintendent receives health insurance coverage for himself and his family through a health insurance plan offered by the Town;

WHEREAS, a qualifying event occurred under the terms of Town's health insurance plan which required the discontinuance of health insurance coverage for certain individuals covered under the Highway Superintendent's plan;

WHEREAS, the Town expended sums to cover family members of the Highway Superintendent after the qualifying event resulting in the Town overpaying for this health insurance coverage;

WHEREAS, the Highway Superintendent and the Town desire to enter into an agreement wherein the Highway Superintendent will reimburse the Town for sums improperly paid by the Town for said health insurance coverage;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board approves the Reimbursement Agreement with Highway Superintendent Todd Martin, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Supervisor is authorized, directed and empowered to execute the Reimbursement Agreement and take all actions necessary to effectuate the terms of said Reimbursement Agreement;
