WHEREAS, Paul Feuerman and Bruce Grivetti, petitioners in a Tax Certiorari Proceeding brought in 2022 pursuant to Article 7 of the New York Real Property Tax Law, against the Town of Clinton, the Assessor for the Town of Clinton and the Town of Clinton Board of Assessment Review seeking reduction of the assessment of the following properties located in the Town of Clinton designated by tax identification numbers 132400-6468-00-456078-0000 (Schultzville Rd.) and 132400-6468-00-572046-000 (Schultzville Rd.), and

WHEREAS, the attorney for petitioners, Van DeWater & Van DeWater, LLP, Kyle W. Barnett, Esq., and the attorney for the Town of Clinton, Cappillino, Rothschild & Egan LLP, Shane J. Egan, Esq., have entered into a tentative settlement agreement of the Tax Certiorari Proceeding, subject to approval by the Town Board, whereby the assessed value of the property would be reduced in accordance with the proposed Consent Judgment, which is annexed hereto and made a part hereof, as follows:

Egan, Esq., to enter into a settlement agreement with the attorney for petitioners, Van DeWater & Van DeWater, LLP, Kyle W. Barnett, Esq., the terms of which are set forth in the attached Consent Judgment and hereby authorizes the attorney for the Town of Clinton, Cappillino,

Rothschild & Egan LLP, Shane J. Egan, Esq., to sign said Consent Judgment on behalf of the Town of Clinton.
