Agreement for the Expenditure of Highway Moneys

AGREEMENT between the Town Highway Superintendent of the **Town of Clinton**, **Dutchess County**, **New York**, and the undersigned members of the Town Board.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 284 of the Highway Law, we agree that moneys levied and collected in the Town for the repair and improvement of highways, and received from the State for State Aid for the repair and improvement of highways, shall be expended as follows:
