

RESOLUTION _____ of 2023

At a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Clinton, held at Town of Clinton Town Hall, 1215 Center Road, Rhinebeck, New York, on the 12th day of September, 2023, at 6:30 p.m.,

Town Supervisor, Michael Whitton, called the meeting to order, and upon roll call, the following were present:

WHEREAS, Louie Fields LLC, petitioner in Tax Certiorari Proceedings brought in 2022 and 2023 pursuant to Article 7 of the New York Real Property Tax Law, against the Town of Clinton, the Assessor for the Town of Clinton and the Town of Clinton Board of Assessment Review seeking reduction of the assessment of the following properties located in the Town of Clinton designated by tax identification numbers 132400-6566-00-412985-0000 (689 Schultzville Rd.) and 132400-6567-00-300289-0000 (Schultzville Rd.), and

WHEREAS, the attorney for the petitioner, Corbally Gartland & Rappleyea, LLP, Allan B. Rappleyea Esq., and the attorney for the Town of Clinton, Cappillino, Rothschild & Egan LLP, Shane J. Egan, Esq., have entered into a tentative settlement agreement of the Tax Certiorari Proceedings, subject to approval by the Town Board, whereby the assessed value of the properties would be reduced in accordance with the proposed Consent Judgment, which is annexed hereto and made a part hereof, as follows:

Rothschild & Egan LLP, Shane J. Egan, Esq., to sign said Consent Judgment on behalf of the Town of Clinton.
