GUIDE TO RECYCLING

Effective November 1, 2018, there will be some changes in Clinton's recycling process. The following information describes and summarizes the new process. The folder provides much more detail as to what is accepted or not accepted in each recycling category.

- Corrugated cardboard is the same
- Glass separation is new and includes the traditional bottles and jars
- Mixed paper is new and excludes wax or plastic-coated milk cartons, tissue materials, and pizza boxes
- Container includes two categories – plastic and metal. Plastic includes only bottles, jugs, and tubs and <u>excludes</u> all film plastic, styrofoam, and all plastic clamshells. The metal now includes metal lids from jars and cans
- The last category is what is included in your garbage. It includes styrofoam, all plastic clamshells, corrugated plastic signs, wax or plastic-coated paper cartons, and snack food bags

All the recycled materials must be clean, with lids removed. Do not tie bundles or

bag any items. For more information, please contact the Royal staff at the Recycling Center during operation hours.
