PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT the Zoning Board of Appeals of the Town of Clinton, New York, will hold a public hearing on **Thursday, March 25, 2021** at 7:30 p.m. or as soon thereafter as it appears on the agenda via Zoom videoconference consistent with Executive Orders 202.1 and 202.15, as extended, addressing the COVID-19 virus on the request of **Jeffrey and Frederique Zacharia** on property located at 1556 Hollow Road Road, **Tax Grid No. 6566-00-257242** in an AR5 Zoning District.

The applicants seek an area variance to Sec. 250 Attachment 2 reducing the following front yard setback to permit construction of an addition to the existing house and barn after these two structures are combined.

Existing House – Front yard setback reduction from 100' to 20'
Existing Barn - Front yard setback reduction from 100' to 40'
Proposed Addition- Front Yard setback reduction from 100' 35.5'
