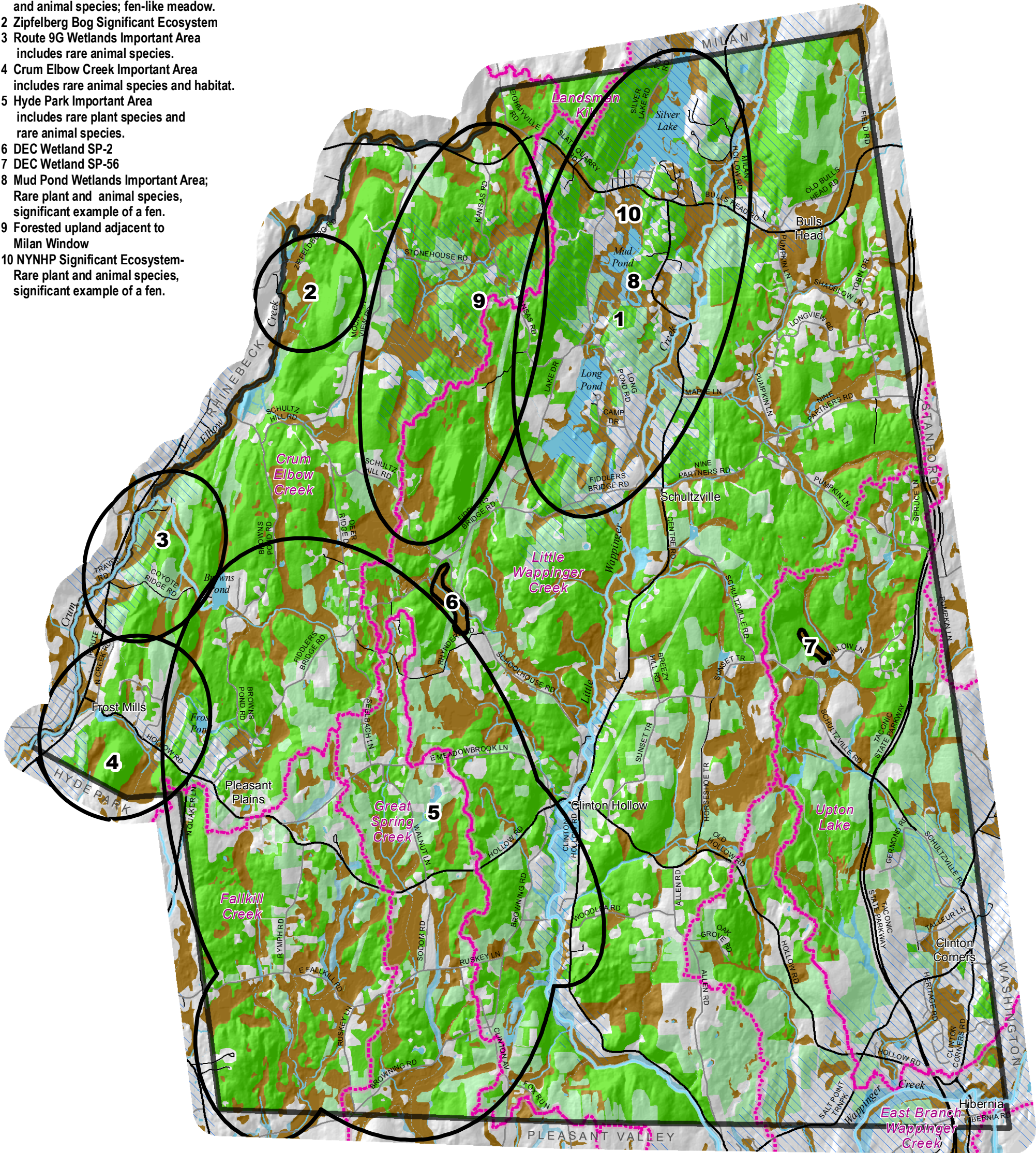


Map 2: Open Space Map, Ecological Resources

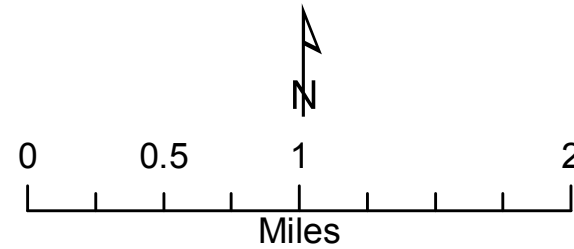
Town of Clinton, Dutchess County, New York

- 1 Milan Window – Four circumneutral bog lakes, variety of wetlands, rare plant and animal species; fen-like meadow.
- 2 Zipfelberg Bog Significant Ecosystem
- 3 Route 9G Wetlands Important Area includes rare animal species.
- 4 Crum Elbow Creek Important Area includes rare animal species and habitat.
- 5 Hyde Park Important Area includes rare plant species and rare animal species.
- 6 DEC Wetland SP-2
- 7 DEC Wetland SP-56
- 8 Mud Pond Wetlands Important Area; Rare plant and animal species, significant example of a fen.
- 9 Forested upland adjacent to Milan Window
- 10 NYNHP Significant Ecosystem- Rare plant and animal species, significant example of a fen.
